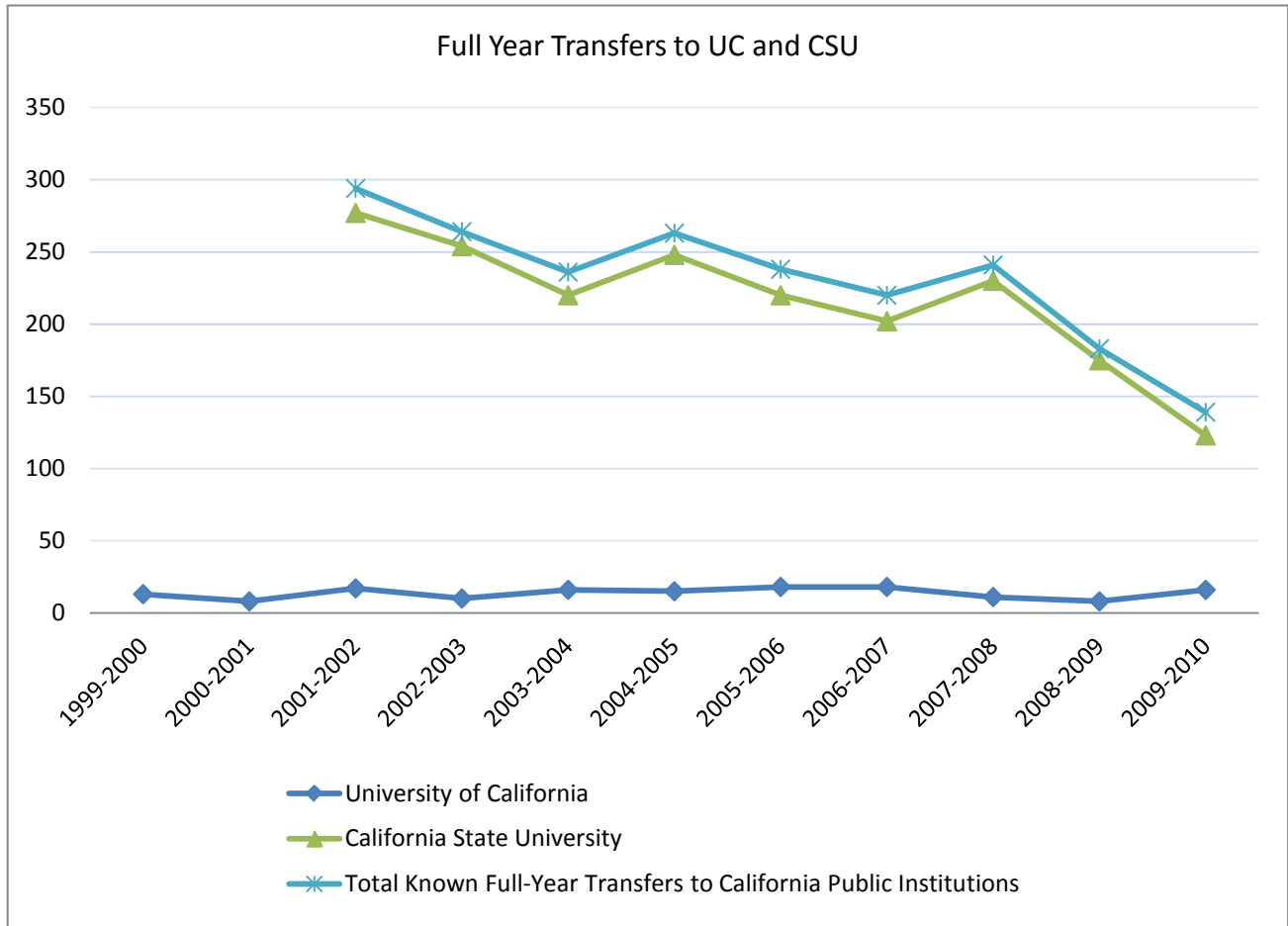

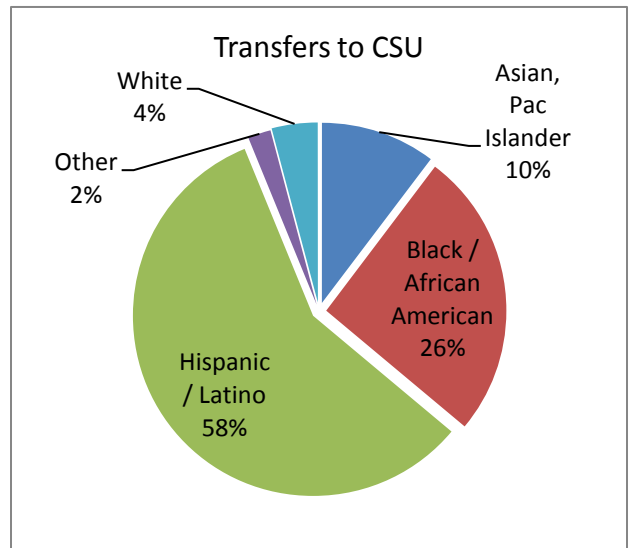

Ethnic Distribution of Transfers to University of California, California State University and Private Colleges Fall 2010



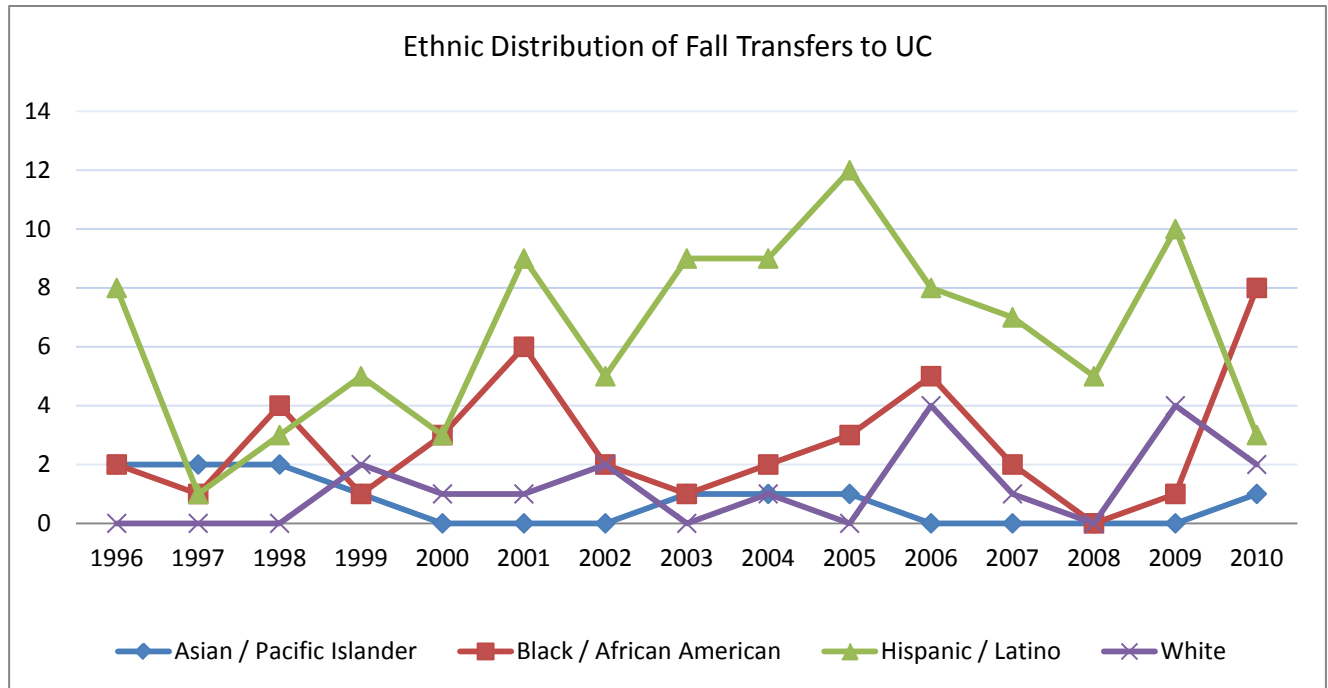

Fall 1996 - Fall 2010

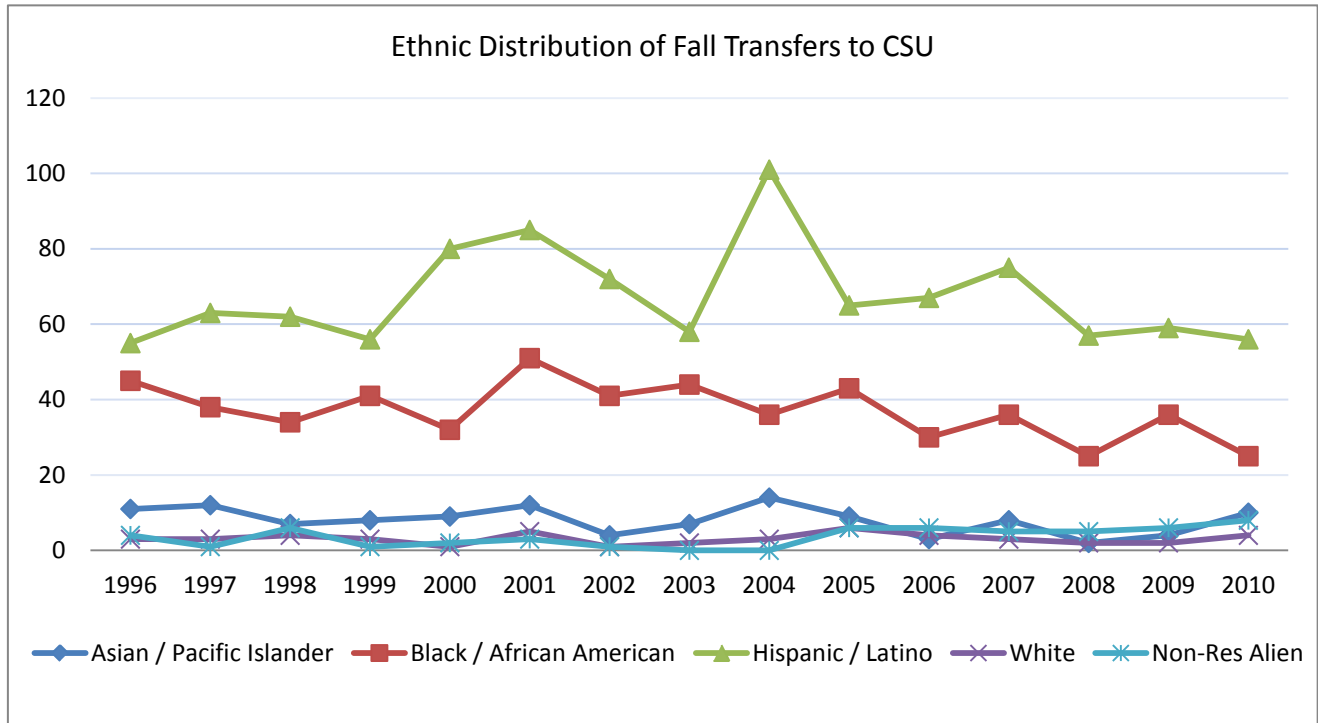

Fall 1996 - Fall 2010

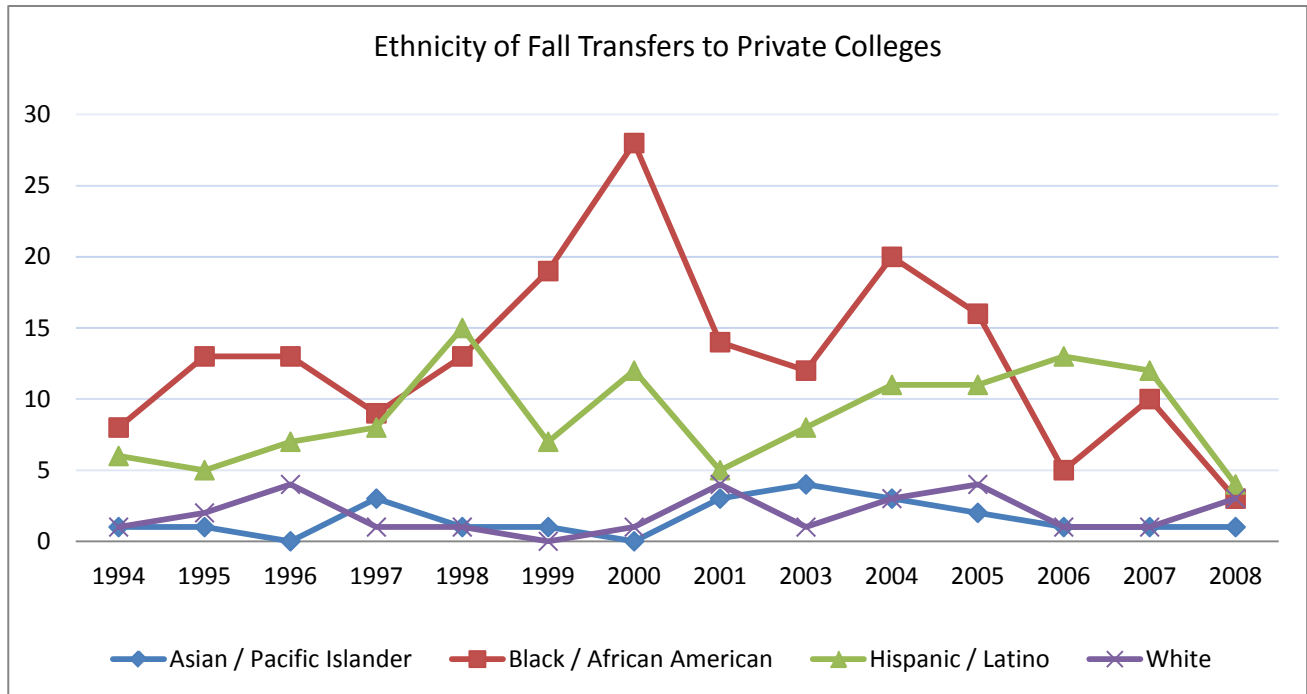
